The National Achievers Society is a prestigious National Honor Society that motivates students to pursue their goal of higher education and encourages their participation in cultural and academic activities. Since 2010, students who have graduated from Palm Beach County Center of Excellence have earned academic scholarships and attended some of the top universities in the country such as Stanford, MIT, and Yale. **The deadline to apply is September 30, 2021.**

Program Purpose:

- Encourage, recognize, and reinforce academic achievement among minority youth
- Increase the pool of college-bound minority students
- Enhance a student's self-esteem and educational motivation
- Energize adults to rededicate themselves to preparing children to meet the academic and job standards of the 21st Century

As part of the organization's efforts to increase the number of well-rounded, academically and culturally talented students who apply to the most exclusive colleges, achievers have the opportunity to participate in an array of programs such as:

- Attending cultural activities including ballet and theater productions
- Leadership trainings and professional development sessions
- SAT/ACT prep courses
- Meet and network with community leaders
- Community service projects, literacy activities, field trips, and academic competitions

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About National Achievers Society

The National Achievers Society is formerly known as the McKnight Achievers Society. Founded in 1953, McKnight Achievers Society was established to identify and motivate historically disadvantaged minority students and ultimately increase the pool of students who are motivated and qualified to enter college. In 1985, the Centers of Excellence were established to continue with the mission. Ten centers operate throughout the State of Florida. The Centers' mission includes: a) assuming a more proactive stance in the education of youth; b) employing the development of a group achievement model for disadvantaged elementary and secondary students; and, c) increasing the pool of students who are prepared, motivated and qualified to enter higher education. National Achievers Society Eligibility Criteria

To be recommended for the National Achievers Society, the applicant must:

- Be a full-time student in a Palm Beach County private, public, or charter secondary school.
- Be enrolled in 6th through 11th grade at the time of the application.
- Earn grades of A's and B's. Students may earn a "C" in only one advanced class. Students with grades of D's or F's will not be considered.
- Not be in remedial classes. Students in remedial classes such as intensive reading or math are not eligible for NAS, although they may be eligible for other programs offered by the Urban League of Palm Beach County.
- Be sponsored by an adult in the state who agrees to serve as the "significant other" in the Achiever's life.
- Submit a Law of Life Essay, minimum of 200 words and maximum of 500 words.
- Submit two letters of recommendations, one of which must be from a school official.
- Attend the induction ceremony.

Membership Guidelines

Members of the National Achievers Society must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Maintain a minimum of 3.0 grade point average
- Participate in meetings
- Participate in at least one community services project
- Submit report cards every grading period
- Attend and participate in one induction ceremony each year
- Submit forms and requested information on time
- Adhere to all deadlines
