## **COVID/FLU Immunization Event**



Urban League of Palm Beach County and Walgreens held a COVID and FLU Immunization Clinic on December 7, 2022 at Gaines Park. The focus for this event was to 1) provide the Pfizer Booster and Flu Shot to low-income families who were either slow to obtain their second or third COVID-19 Booster shot, and 2) administer the FLU shots to families throughout Palm Beach County. Walgreens made 50 COVID-19 Boosters and 50 Flu shots available to families and clients of ULPBC.

The YEB was created by NULITES and NAS program participants seeking to raise funds for scholarships for graduating seniors transitioning to post-secondary education. Several students participated in the program as well as four key community partners including: Javoris Ingram, **Enterprise Holdings; Alfred Malefatto, Lewis, Longman and** Walker PA; Bill Siegel, WPTV News Channel 5; and Heidi Reuwer, Valley Bank. They discussed their long-standing relationship with ULPBC and their drive to positively impact the PBC community.


